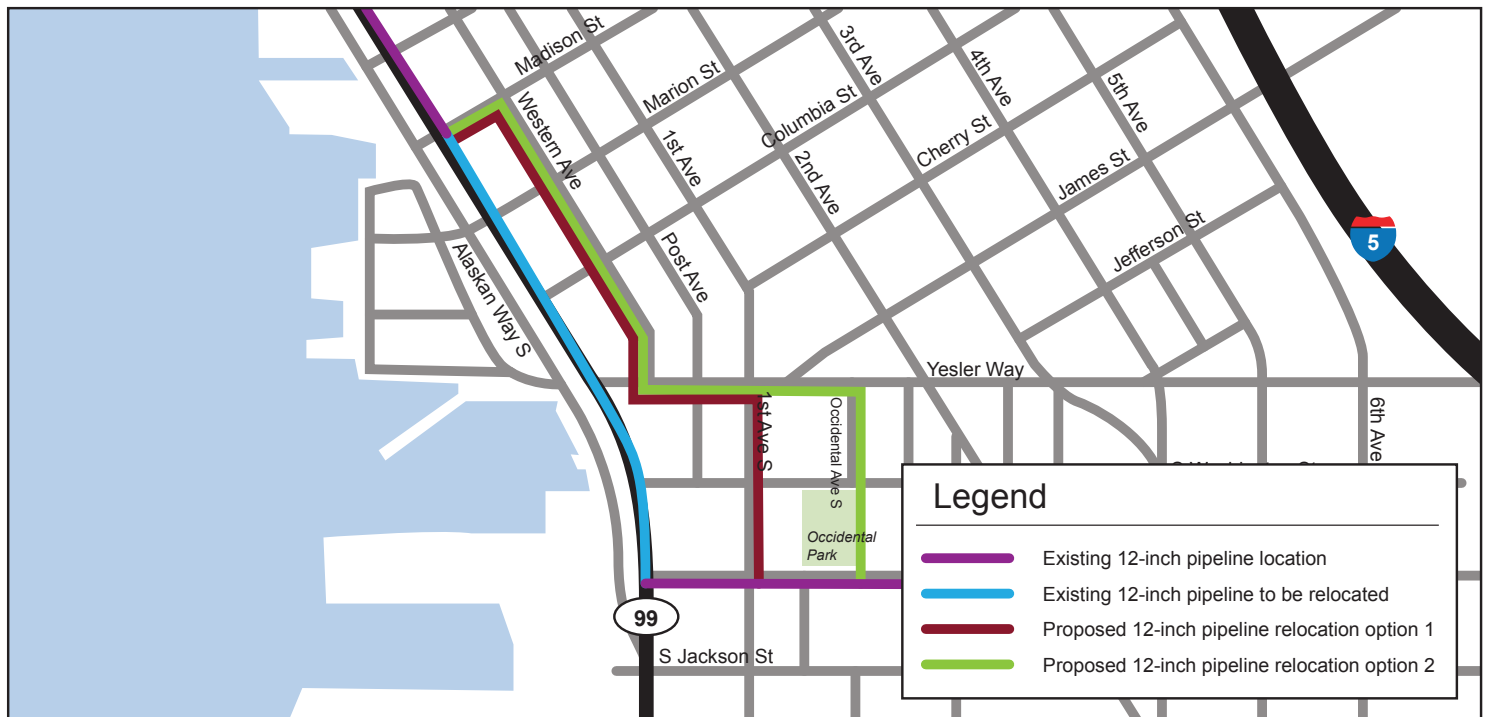


Public meeting on PSE natural gas system relocation work in Pioneer Square area

PSE is currently in the route selection phase for the relocated pipeline segment.
